<u>Awards:</u> \$750 to awardee and \$250 to awardees' school science program, preferably earth science or biology departments, to help provide equipment or field trips/educational enhancement opportunities.

<u>Eligibility:</u> High School Seniors, including homeschooled students, whose school district has students living within the Lake George Watershed: Bolton Landing, Lake George, Ticonderoga or Whitehall (also - students who are year-round residents of Hulett's Landing).

<u>To Apply:</u> Submit an essay between 1000 and 2000 words covering the annual question. The questions will be creatively based in exploring the relationship of land and water – specifically, dealing with the relationship's impact on the water quality within the Lake George Watershed. Essays are to be submitted to the Lake George Land Conservancy (LGLC) via email to hbartonbenedict@lglc.org. Please use the LGLC's website, www.lglc.org, as a reference or call 518-644-9673. 2013 Essay Question:

What will Lake George be like 200 years from now? What will your descendants be doing on and around Lake George, and how will their experiences on Lake George be different from yours today?

Essay Submission Deadline: April 1st, 2013

Award Decision: The winner will be announced by June 1st. The awardee will be asked to attend LGLC's Annual Meeting to receive their check during an awards ceremony. The 2013 Annual Meeting will take place at the Lake George Club in Diamond Point, NY, the afternoon of Monday, July 15th.
