1. A Holiday order form is enclosed. Please list your phone number plus your first and second choices for stamps.
2. Payment is by check made payable to US Postal Service (USPS) or Postmaster.
3. Holiday stamps are all "Forever." Regular postage is 4.9 cents or \$9.80 for a book of 20 stamps.
4. The International Forever Wreath (pictured to the right) costs \$1.15 each. They are global "Forever" and are used for all foreign countries.
5. If you don't see what you want listed on the order form, just write it in.
6. Also enclosed is an extra order form to use during the year.
7. The "Christmas Magi" stamp book goes on sale November 19th. All other choices illustrated here are currently in stock.
