

Hulett's Gallery and Library Opening Party

Wednesday July 15 marked the first public opening of the "Hulett's Gallery and Library". About 150 people attended and seemed to receive the new look well. People wandered the displays, which are displayed on open plan boards intermingled with new bookshelves.



On display were a number of large size reproductions of Hulett's Landing postcards from the collection of Judy Haggett, as well as other memorabilia for the FHHL collection.
