Dear Huletts Landing Resident:

I would like to take a few moments to briefly update you on a couple of projects occurring in the Huletts Landing area to make sure that everyone is up to speed on the projects.

Foster Brook Delta Removal: Permitting for this project was submitted in January of 2008. We have not yet received a final permit for the project from the Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC). We do have a draft permit and that is not expected to change, so we should see the final permit soon. We are also still working on a permit from the Adirondack Park Agency (APA) for disposal of the delta material.

As per financing, we only have about half of the funding in place to complete the project at this point. The total cost is estimated to be around \$75,000. We are submitting grant proposals to secure funding for the other portion and should know if we are successful sometime in late July. If we secure funding, we are aiming for a fall 2009 dredging project. The DEC does not allow dredging in that area after October 1st.

Fairy Brook Sediment Basin: This project would construct an in-stream sediment basin in Fairy Brook just south of Marina Way. We have submitted permit applications to the DEC, APA and the Army Corps of Engineers. No permits have been issued for the basin, but we have been asked by the APA and Army Corps to submit additional materials.

The total project costs for the basin are estimated at \$60,000. Funding for this project is only at about one-fifth of what is needed to complete the project. We are including this project in one of the Federal Green Initiative Grant proposals that will be sent out at the end of this month.
